You're invited to our Arizona District Rifle Match and clinic. This event is open to Rangers and Non-Rangers, Boys and Girls, First Time Shooters and Seasoned Competitors alike. Don't miss out on a day of pure clean fun for the whole family! Discovery Rangers and up, 3rd grade and older for the non-rangers joining us.

We will be participating in the National Postal Matches operated in cooperation with the NSSP and the NRA. For those not too keen on competing just yet, we will also have alternative targets and coaching available so you can try your aim for the first time, or just warm up before competing! Don't know, how to shoot, but want to? Come on out, we will teach you.

Matches and shooting will be occurring steadily throughout the day, it will take approximately one hour to complete the entire course of fire.

It is recommended that boys complete their Firearms Safety Merit before attending, but it is not required.

Food is not included in this, however will be available for purchase on site or at a nearby restaurant.

All minors but be accompanied by a commander or parent. Parents are encouraged to attend. All minors must have the permission form filled out.

Smallbore and Blackpowder Clinic

The clinic is open to anybody third grade and up. Shooters do not need their firearms safety card, but it is strongly recommended. No age groups, or competition, just a fun time learning to shoot rifles. Come on out and learn to shoot, and see what competition is all about!

EQUIPMENT

Rifles and Ammunition are Provided.

COURSE OF FIRE -30 Shots total at 50 feet. 10 Shots prone in 1 1/2 min per record shot. 10 shots standing in 1 1/2 min per record shot. 10 shots kneeling in 1 1/2 min per record shot. Targets are to be fired in the order stated above.

Adult: Must be member of church that has a chartered Outpost.

* To compete as an 18 year old junior, the competitor must be an Expedition Ranger and may not be serving as an Assistant Group Leader in the Outpost.

RULES

EQUIPMENT

If you do not have your own, rifles and ammunition will be available to use, you may bring your own as long as they conform to the following rules.

See NRA Muzzle Loading Rifle, Pistol, & Shotgun Rule Book, section 3.2(a) & (b) with the following exception: Wiping out of barrels between shots is permitted. Muzzle

Loading Black Powder rifles with either smoothbore or rifled barrels will be permitted. Patched round balls are the only approved projectile. Shotguns, in-line rifles or pistols are not permitted. "Sabot" bullets are not permitted.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Shots will be fired at:

25 yards B-19 Target. Cross-sticks sitting. Best 10 of 13 fired shots for record score.

50 yards B-6 Target. Prone. Best 10 of 13 fired shots for record score.

POWDER: Black powder or other approved substitutes are allowed.
