

Congratulations! You have successfully completed the first step in becoming a member of the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship. You are to be commended on your dedication to the Royal Rangers program by completing the requirements necessary to attend the Frontier Adventure.

You are now eligible to participate in the Frontier Adventure. The Frontier Adventure will begin promptly at **7 pm on March 29, 2019** at **Dugas campsite** (see map on flyer on District website: www.azroyalrangers.com Events tab). The Frontier Adventure is a two-day event and you will be required to be at camp from Friday evening through Saturday evening. Friday's dinner and Saturday's breakfast and lunch will be provided. You are required to have the following items at the time the Adventure begins on Friday.

Congratulations again on showing yourself worthy of FCF membership. Now finish the Frontier Adventure and become a member of the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship. The Frontier Adventure will include a series of tests and tasks that will need to be completed in order to gain membership into the chapter. The Frontier Adventure Ceremony will be held March 30th at 7 pm – please plan on staying through the ceremony.

In preparation for the Frontier Adventure, you will need to print a copy of the Frontiersman Workbook and become familiar with its contents. This must be brought with you to your Frontier Adventure. This workbook can be found on the National FCF website, www.nationalfcf.com

The theme of the Frontier Adventure is “The Great Commandment – Love thy Neighbor”. As a Frontiersmen member of the FCF you will be expected to become a Torchbearer, one who shines his light in a dark world. As part of the event, you will also need to memorize and recite the following scriptures:

Matthew 22:37-40 (NIV): Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

John 13:35 (NIV): By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
