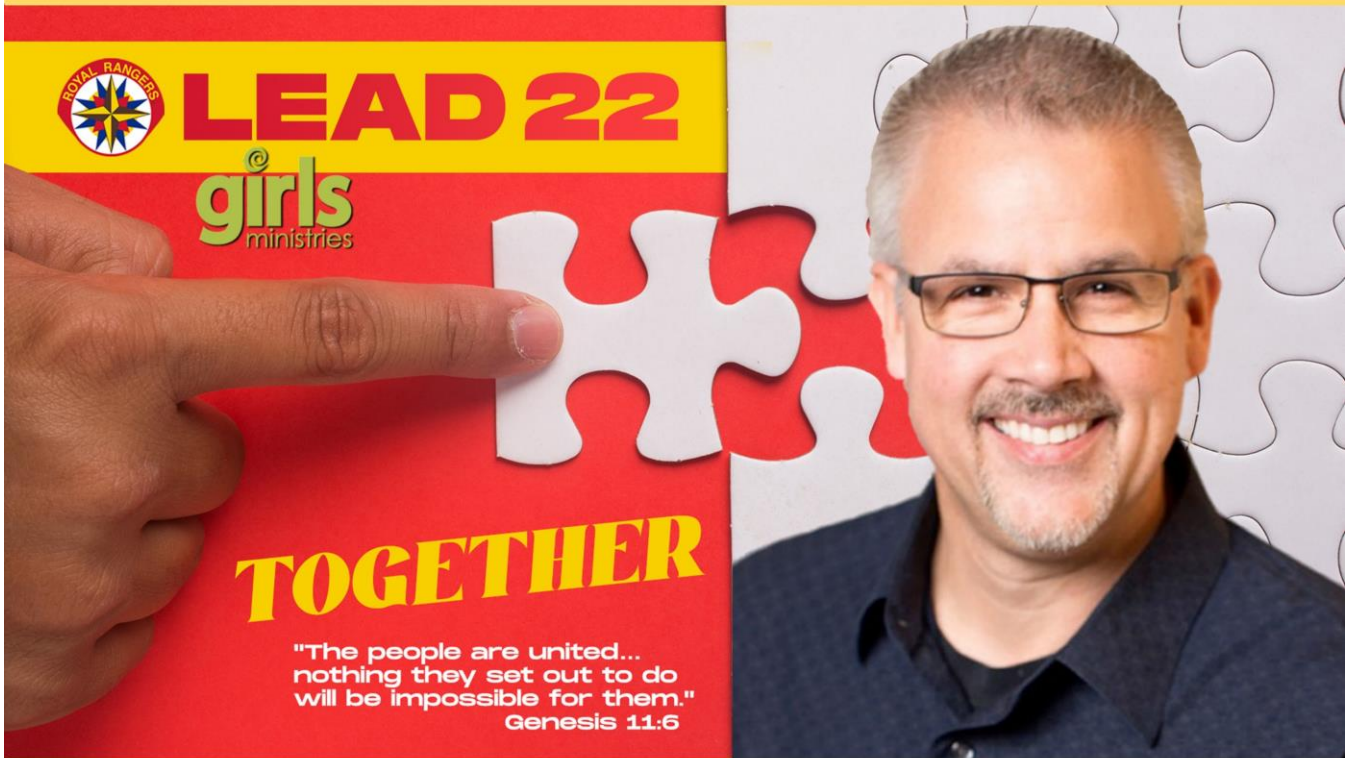

National Shooting Sports Program Training

NRA Range Safety Officer (RSO) Course – 8 hrs - \$55.00 class fee plus NRA registration fee - \$30 - \$50

The RSO course content consists of RSO's roles and responsibilities, range standard operating procedures, range inspection and range rules, firearm stoppages and malfunctions, and Range Safety Briefings which include procedures to follow in case of an emergency. NRA Black Powder Course – 12 hrs - \$55.00 fee

A SIGNED PERMISSION SLIP FROM A PARENT OR GUARDIAN IS REQUIRED FOR PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18. ADVENTURE & EXPEDITION RANGERS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THE AIRGUN SAFETY MERIT OR A PREVIOUS FIREARM SAFETY MERIT MAY ATTEND. ADULT LEADERS & PARENTS WELCOME TO ATTEND.

IT'S RECOMMENDED YOU BRING YOUR OWN BLACK POWDER RIFLE AND KIT FOR THIS CLASS. DON'T BRING YOUR FIREARMS OR POWDER INTO THE CLASSROOM PORTION. YOU WILL BRING THOSE ITEMS TO THE RANGE ON SATURDAY WHEN YOU DO LIVE FIRE.

IF YOU DON'T HAVE A BLACK POWDER KIT THE INSTRUCTORS WILL HAVE SEVERAL BLACK POWDER RIFLES AVAILABLE FOR YOU TO SHOOT AT THE RANGE.

WE WILL HAVE CLASS AT THE CHURCH ON FRIDAY EVENING AND CLASS WILL BE HELD AT THE PRADO SHOOTING PARK FOR THE LIVE SHOOTING PORTION OF THE COURSE ON SATURDAY.

PERMISSION FORM

For Royal Rangers Camps

BB GUNS / Air Rifles / Archery / Sling Shots / Paintball / Small Bore Rifles / Shot Guns / Black Powder Firearms / or any other Firearms and Ammunition.

This form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian and turned in before a minor will be allowed to handle or shoot BB Guns / Air Rifles / Archery / Sling Shots / Paintball / Small Bore Rifles / Shotguns / Black Powder Firearms / or any other Firearm or handle any ammunition. Minors will not be allowed to handle or shoot without a signed parental permission form. All boys shooting will be supervised by a trained RSO (Range Safety Officer) at all times.

CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE SECTIONS

Penal Code 29650 - "A minor shall not possess live ammunition"

Penal Code 29655 - "section 29650 shall not apply if one of the following circumstances exists: (a) the minor has the written consent of a parent or legal guardian to possess live ammunition. (b) The minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. (c) The minor is actively engaged in or is going to or from a lawful recreational sport, including, but not limited to, competitive shooting, or agricultural or ranching or hunting activity where the nature of which involves the use of a firearm.

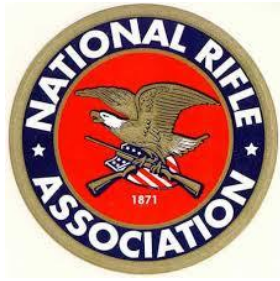
Penal Code 19915 (a) - "Every person who furnishes any BB device to a minor, without the express or implied permission of a parent or legal guardian, is guilty of a misdemeanor". NRA RANGE SAFETY OFFICER COURSE

\$55.00 PER PERSON (This is a private course for Royal Ranger Commanders attending the conference – Pay your fee on day of class)

Pre-Registration is required online at (NRAInstructors.org – Click on Find a course, scroll to Safety Class, click on NRA Basic Range Safety Officer Course , go to Search and put in zip code 92703. Go to class listed on 3/12/22 in Santa Ana and register)

Must be 21 years of age minimum. It's recommended that you join the NRA prior to the course as you get a discount on your NRA RSO 2 year Instructor fee. The NRA fee is separate from the class fee. You will need to register with the NRA and pay a \$50.00 fee for non-NRA member and a \$30.00 fee for being an NRA member. This is done after successful completion of the course.

The National Royal Ranger Office now recommends that Royal Ranger Commanders who are running firearm related courses or ranges have an NRA certification as an RSO. This is for Liability purposes and Safety
