## Survival Action Camp Bring List

- 1) A copy of this page
- 2) Small folding stool or camp chair
- 3) Prescription medications.
- 4) Sharpened pencils and pen (2 each).
- 5) One 6'x8' tarp (Harbor Freight Wal-Mart / Amazon)
- 6) Sleeping Bag rated to 40 degrees. Weather is expected to be mid 70s in the day, low 50s at night
- 7) Ground Mat ( DO NOT bring air mattress.) Wal-Mart / Amazon
- 8) Three pair of high-quality hiking socks (do not buy cotton socks, wool is best)
- 9) Pair of light duty gloves
- 10) Two warm sweaters.
- 11) Two pairs of jeans or cargo pants
- 12) Pair of hiking boots. One pair of tennis shoes
- 13) Extra Clothes (Underwear, long-sleeved shirts, etc.)
- 14) Canteen or water bottle
- 15) Sharp lock blade pocketknife
- 16) Personal Toilet Kit with soap, toothbrush & toothpaste, **include deodorant please!**
- 17) Fanny pack or small backpack to hold all the following survival items:
  - a) Small folding shovel
  - b) Multitool Leatherman / Gerber or Sog
  - c) Rain Poncho with hood. Wal-Mart / Amazon
  - d) 50 to 100 feet of paracord (\$8 on Amazon)
  - e) Emergency Blanket. Wal-Mart / Amazon
  - f) Emergency Whistle (Use for signaling).
  - g) Flashlights, head lights are best @ Wal-Mart (Extra batteries also)
  - h) Metal match
  - i) Chapstick
  - j) Siva Style compass
  - k) Salt and pepper packets (4 each)
  - l) 4 bouillon cubes
  - m) Bag of favorite trail mix(for use only during 24 hour survival testing period)**
- 18) Six Plastic grocery bags with no holes in them (the free ones,) for wet/dirty clothes
- 19) A copy of this list.
